






1. Remove the back cover.


Insert the micro-SIM card gold-coloured contacts facing downwards. Insert the battery.

4. Replace the back cover.








### **CONNECT VIA WI-FI**







- Power on the device.
- You can find the Wi-Fi credentials by removing the back cover and having a look above the battery.
- From your PC, tablet or other device, connect to Domino's Wi-Fi network using credentials.
- 4. Once connected launch a Web browser, Domino's Home page should be automatically displayed. If not then type in the following URL: http://domino or http://192.168.1.1 in case the home page doesn't load.





- (Optional) if PIN code is requested you can find this on the SIM card documentation and type it on the pop-up screen.
- 5. Domino will connect to Internet:
  - a) Home page will display "Orange F" network.
  - b) Domino will display a steady blue or green light.


Battery power
